SAFETY REPORT

- Safety at a Glance Report
 - o 2023 Safety Review & Strategic Plan
 - OSHA Fatal Four: Caught in or Between, Struck by, Falls, Electrocution
 - Focus Four:
 - Caught in or Between, Struck By, TMA Crashes, and Fatigue.
- PK Employee Safety Survey
 - Safety Team develop strategies to address issues
- Think Zero Culture (a company culture with the mission of Zero Incidents, Injuries, and Defects)
 Expand the program for the 2023 season
- Lack of enforcement of MDOT WZ requirements/specifications in the field

The time (5 week program) + cost too made the program prohibitive to set up a training program inside PK.

TECHNOLOGY

- PAWS Grant PK/Mixon Hill TerraForm development partnership
 - o 2023 Pilot Program (if successful begin in March 2023)
- Tiny Mobile Layout Robot:
 - Two frontline companies have Tiny Mobile Layout robot. Recommend using existing robots before purchasing another. Train operator to use the existing units.
- Camera Systems
 - o 1) Video
 - i. In Cab cameras pointed in the cab with artificial intelligence (AI) alerts driver when seat belt is not worn, when fatigue or cell phone use is detected.
 - ii. External Cameras picking up 360 degree view of surroundings. Value is in the education and awareness of surroundings for training purposes or capturing hit &

- 2) Telematics: Value options:
 - i. Private (PK) showing the location of the PK & provide selected data mileage, truck speed is of low value right now.
 - ii. Public Showing the location of PK trucks on a public web page and an alert sent to other drivers when approaching PK pavement marking crews is valuable.
